The event will be held at St Mary's Church in Conwy Town.

Will there be staff, barriers and signs to help people move around this event safely? |

The maximum number of people this event can hold is 300 people.

There will be banners located at the entrances to the church yard.

There will also be volunteers at entrances directing people in and out of the venue.

Will there be any loud repetitive lights or sounds at this event? |

Directional coloured lighting will be cast on the artists as they perform on the staging area.

The surrounding areas will be darkened. The performance is in the evening and it will be dark outside.

Instruments will be connected to amplifiers with which the band will be playing loud music

Seating will be at least 1 metre away from sound sources.

The church hall is large and there will be echoes and vibrations.

What sounds, sights and smells might one encounter at this event? Is there provision available to help alleviate these? (I.e. breakout space, light reducing shades, ear defenders) |

Due to the limitations of the church the only breakout space available is the sheltered porch of the church's west entrance.

Amdani! Conwy volunteers will be able request ear defenders and light reducing shades before this event.
