### Report: Beacons Cymru X Winter Sounds 2022

### **Beacons Cymru Delivered:**

- 1 x Focus Group with 3 x young people (18-25) from the Conwy region (paid to take part). The 3 x young people discussed issues pertinent to the music industry and talent development pathways in Conwy. This followed a short call-out period which attracted 8 x applications.
- 2 x Penderyn Distillery live session videos (filmed and edited by TAPE) with emerging artists based in Conwy: M. Yesekaon and Rosa Lavenne.
- 1 x music industry 'Basecamp' event at TAPE on Friday 2nd December. Co-produced with the 3 x young Focus Group participants, this included: 1 x songwriting workshop, 1 x DJ workshop, 3 x music industry panels, 1 x live sound workshop, networking opportunities, and 1 x live performance from a Conwy-based band.

### **Key Research Findings:**

#### Focus Group (Prior to Basecamp Event)

The 3 x Focus Group participants discussed their following perceptions of the music industry and talent development pathways in the Conwy region:

- A general lack of (or at least, awareness of) music industry infrastructure (e.g. grassroots music venues, recording studios, rehearsal spaces), opportunities and potential mentors in the region.
- A limited number of live events are happening, but there seems to be a lack of awareness.
- Audiences seem to prefer to go to Manchester (or other English cities) for shows.
- Lack of diversity in 'behind the scenes' music industry roles in the region predominantly white, male, older.
- A lack of 'stepping stones' beyond traditional education (aside from TAPE, the group couldn't name anything).
- Transport: getting around the region can be difficult.
- People generally move away from the region to carve music careers.

#### Basecamp Survey (During / After Basecamp Event)

14 out of 33 x Basecamp attendees responded to a survey which was distributed during and after the event.

- Just 14.3% of Basecamp survey respondents indicated that they believe there is enough music industry infrastructure (e.g. grassroots music venues, recording studios, rehearsal spaces), opportunities and potential mentors in the Conwy region.
- 61.6% of Basecamp survey respondents indicated that they were unsure of how to get involved in Conwy's live music scene, either as a performer or working behind the scenes.
- 63.6% of survey respondents indicated that the Basecamp event increased their music industry knowledge.
- 81.8% of survey respondents indicated that the Basecamp event introduced them to like-minded young people.

### **Long Term Recommendations:**

Based on the above findings, we recommend that the Local Authority considers implementing/supporting the following recommendations:

 A regional 'music forum' in which matters relating to the music industry and talent development pathways continue to be discussed and tackled.


- A regional Young Promoters Network (see: <a href="www.beacons.cymru/theypn">www.beacons.cymru/theypn</a>) to instill confidence and skills in young promoters.
- Entrepreneurial guidance empowering young people to build opportunity / infrastructure from the ground up.
- A grassroots gig guide akin to Minty's Gig Guide in Cardiff, to improve awareness of live music events in the Conwy region.

### Participants' Data



They **do not** include data relating to the young team employed by TAPE to film and edit the Penderyn Sessions and Basecamp evidence videos. Access to this information has been requested.


### Participants: Place of Residence




### Participants: Gender




# Participants: Disabilities




# Participants: Ethnicity
