Starting in Pride Month of 2024, three **crafting workshops** were held at Conwy Culture Centre, where members of the public could come and learn about the history of 'zines' (self-published magazines), then create some of their own. Each workshop started with a small introduction to the concept of zines which included their popularity within and their links to the history of the LGBTQ+ community. The sessions were led by local artist and zine publisher Victor Langdon-Lewis.

The workshops were aimed at adults and people in their late teens, and the groups that came enjoyed their sessions. They were interested to learn about zines and engage in a creative activity, with participants sharing that they were proud of what they had made and happy to have taken part. The workshops were accessible to and included disabled participants.
